## **RESOLUTION NO. 2022-01**

A RESOLUTION IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE PROVISIONS OF K.S.A. 75-1120a.

This resolution shall be made for the purpose of complying with the provisions of K.S.A. 75-1120a, as the Board of County Commissioners of Chautauqua County, Kansas, intend to waive the requirement of Subsection (a) of said section.

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners has determined that the financial statements and financial reports for the year ended 2022 to be prepared in conformity with the requirements of K.S.A. 75-1120a are not relevant to the requirements of the cash basis and budget laws of this state and are of no significant value to the governing body or the members of the general public of Chautauqua County, Kansas; and

WHEREAS, there are no revenue bond ordinances or resolutions or other ordinances or resolutions of said municipality which require financial statements and financial reports to be prepared in conformity with said act for the year ended 2022.

Now, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners of Chautauqua County, Kansas, in regular meeting duly assembled this date that said Board of County Commissioners intends to waive and does waive the requirements of said law as it applies to the County of Chautauqua for the year ended 2022.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the said Board of County Commissioners shall cause its financial statements and financial reports of the said municipality to be prepared on the cash basis of cash receipts and disbursements as adjusted to show compliance with the cash basis and budget laws of this state.
