

BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS ELECTION CANVASS

November 13, 2018

Chairman Rodney Shaw called the meeting of the Chautauqua County Board of Canvass to order on Tuesday, November 13, 2018, at 9:00 a.m. in the commission room of the courthouse. Commissioner Goff Searl and Commissioner Jack Carpenter were present as was County Counselor Zoe Newton, County Clerk, Niki Collier, Deputy Clerk Becky Smilko, Ralene Davis and Lindsey Carter.

Election Officer, Niki Collier presented twenty-two Provisional ballots with information about the status of the voter and reason for the provisional ballot, for the Board of Canvass to accept or reject.

The Board of Canvass approved 10 and rejected 12 of the 22 Provisional ballots presented. The Counting Board proceeded to tally the votes in the meeting and provided the results to Election Officer Collier. At 9:30 a.m. Chairman Shaw recessed the Canvass to allow the Election Officer to complete the abstract to include the accepted provisional votes.

At 10:15 a.m. Chairman Shaw resumed the Canvass and Mrs. Collier presented the complete abstract of the vote to Canvassing Board for approval. Once reviewed the Canvassing Board signed the abstract completing the Canvass.

At 10:18 a.m. Chairman Shaw made a motion to adjourn the Board of Canvass for the Primary Election held on November 6, 2018, and Commissioner Searl seconded the motion. Motion carried 3-0.
