## Exposed to COVID-19?

Here are your Quarantine Guidelines in accordance with KDHE

If you are un-vaccinated...

You MUST stay home 14 days after your last exposure to the positive case

## If you are vaccinated...

If you are vaccinated, no quarantine is required; however, it is recommended that you get tested 3-5 days and 7—10 days following your exposure.

AND

Continue to wear a mask, social distance, and avoid large gatherings.

Tested positive for COVID-19?

Here are your Isolation Guidelines in accordance with KDHE

You MUST stay home and away from others for 14 days from onset of symptoms (or positive test if asymptomatic)

AND

You MUST be symptom free without medication for 72-hours before leaving isolation, whichever is longer.

Chautauqua County Health Department is working diligently to slow the spread of COVID-19 within our county. It is a requirement from KDHE that our agency conducts all contact tracing for positive COVID-19 cases. Contact tracing includes isolating persons with a positive COVID-19 test, as well as, quarantining close contacts of the positive individual.

In conclusion, Chautauqua County Health Department isolates and quarantines individuals as a requirement to remain in compliance with KDHE guidelines. All staff from the health department greatly appreciates the understanding from Chautauqua County residents throughout this trying time.
