## **Chautauqua County**

Chautauqua County Medical Director Dr. James McDermott, DO along with Chautauqua County Health Department strongly recommends masks and social distancing to slow the spread of Covid-19. However, Chautauqua County will not mandate masks in public.

As we continue to take measures to ensure the safety of our most vulnerable and limit the spread of COVID-19, it is important for citizens to continue to take precautions as outlined below.

- Refrain from non-essential travel
- Practice social distancing
- Interact only with people of the same household when possible
- Practice good hand hygiene
- Vulnerable/High Risk individuals and senior citizens should stay home as much as possible
